

Easter Message from the Pastor Pastor Pastor

We have been wandering through Lent together these past several weeks. Throughout Lent we have been thinking about what we might let go of. As we let go, we make room to perceive what God might be doing in our midst.

Sometimes ... sometimes as we let go and wander, we find old things. Old things that we need to return to. Things that used to ground us. Things that anchored us in that thin space between Heaven and Earth so that Heaven might be brought to Earth. Sometimes as we wander, we find that we are like the Israelites of old that have come to worship many idols and need to let them go, so that their focus might turn back to God. Sometimes as we wander, we find we have to let go of what we hold on to to pick up the faithfulness and trust of our youth.

Sometimes ... sometimes as we let go and wander, we find new things. New things that might be intimidating. New things that might take some time to adjust to. New things that God has placed in our path. Things so much in our path that we can't help but trip over them. New things that challenge us. New things that confront us. New things that call us to new seasons, as we find in Ecclesiastes.

And *sometimes* ... sometimes as we wander, there is an unveiling, a revealing or revelation of something that has been right in front of us for years. An unveiling like that of Saul who would become Paul. Sometimes, we find we are wandering down the road to Damascus, a well-trodden road, when we find we are blinded by a bright light. It is startling at first. Intimidating. But with a little bit of company and community, in the end we answer a call that reaches far beyond ourselves to the body of Christ that has been waiting for us on the other side the whole time. When we stop and listen, we find the scales fall from our eyes and the people we thought were outside of our community are actually inside of it and waiting for us like blind Ananias the whole time.







I look forward to sharing Holy Week with you all! Good Friday when we might let go of what we nailed to the cross. Holy Saturday when we grieve things we let go of. Then, look forward to Easter morning when, in community, we might pick up something wholly resurrected!
